
Provocation video





5. Place / Physical Distribution: The right place where the consumer can purchase the product with least efforts.



We created this google form so that we could understand global perspectives on entrepreneurship. We gathered responses from all over the globe. It really help us gain insights into entrepreneurship.






How did you find the information you were looking for (interviews, surveys, experiment, articles etc)?




What did you find suprising or intresting

What did you learn about yourself during the exhibition?








